

#### DAY 1: Depart HOME CITY

Each day brings new and unpredictable sights. Depart home this evening for the overnight flight to London. We will be adjusting our time - as we are crossing the International Dateline. Each day of our tour, will bring many new and unpredictable sights. We depart for our overnight flight. (In-flight Meals)

#### Day 02:

Enroute to South Africa, we will have time to relax until we board our connecting flight. We will move our watches once again, as we journey onto South Africa. Excitement!! (In-flight Meals)

#### Day 03:

#### Arrival in Cape Town, South Africa

Welcome to South Africa! On arrival at Cape Town International Airport, we will meet our English Speaking Guide, and transfer by motor coach to the comforts of our hotel.

Our accommodation for THREE nights is conveniently located near the trendy and historic Victoria and Alfred Waterfront in Cape Town, which is



regarded as one of the most "Popular Tourism Developments in the World".

You will have time to relax from our flight, browse and enjoy the many shops. You may like to visit the Two Oceans Aquarium (it's a fantastic aquarium representing the unique marine ecosystem in the Cape, where the cold Atlantic Ocean merges with the warm Indian Ocean). There are flea markets & lots of shopping! This area is very central.

#### Wow.... What A Spectacular View!

As evening approaches, we will be escorted to Table Mountain for a Cableway Ride to the summit, where **traditional African Sundowners** will be served.

Our group will all enjoy the **spectacular views from the summit** as the sun sets.

**Note**: These cable cars are LARGE (each car takes about 40 people inside and fully enclosed with glass windows to look out. **This cable car has a 100% safety record.** They are new and very "up market" cable cars. (Clients do not have to partake)

While on this tour to the summit of Table Mountain there will be a chance to watch the sun go down, a beautiful ending to the day. Most definitely worthwhile!

Following our visit to the Top of Table Mountain we return to our hotel a **Welcome Dinner** at our hotel. Relax and enjoy the views of Cape Town's lovely harbour while you get to know your fellow travelers. Kindly note: Depending on our flight arrival time we may **visit Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens** upon arrival for a brief walk through the gardens. **(In-flight Meals / D)** 

#### Day 04:

Our day begins, with a tasty buffet breakfast. We now meet our English Speaking Guide for the beginning of our exciting Half Day South African Winelands Tour.

**Stellenbosch** lies in a fertile valley surrounded by vineyards, orchards and mountains. The gracious blend of 18-century Cape Dutch, Georgian and Victorian buildings is evident as we stroll down Dorp Street, where massive Oaks still shade original water furrows, then head for one of the nearby wine estates for a **Wine Tasting Session**.

#### Day 04: Cont'd

If time allows, we may also make a stop at **Oom Samie Se Winkel** (if time allows) which is not really a museum, but when entering the over 100 year old grocery store, you will feel like you've been



transported back to the Victorian era!

We now depart Stellenbosch, and travel to the **Milnerton Lighthouse** for a photographic moment to capture the highest peak in Southern Africa, Table Mountain.

The remainder of the day is at leisure, set aside to relax or explore the city's Famous Waterfront or Canal Walk – or you may like to enjoy one of the biggest Malls! The choice is yours! This evening, you may like to join Ron, as he takes the hotel shuttle over to a local restaurant in the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront area. (B)

#### Day 05:

Following our delicious breakfast, we depart from our hotel, with a relaxing **full day to tour** the ruggedly **beautiful Cape Peninsula** via the Atlantic Seaboard.

This tour travels at a pace that allows you to explore the beauty of the Cape Peninsula. Depart for the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve along one of South Africa's most



scenic & popular routes via Sea Point, Clifton, Llandudno and Sandy Bay to Hout Bay.

Continuing over the **impressive Chapman's Peak Drive**, one of the world's most spectacular and scenic routes.

We continue to the Cape Point Nature Reserve where we will "take the magic carpet ride" on the electrically powered funicular railway called the "Flying Dutchman". When you look across the vast ocean, you will get the strange feeling that you are at the end of the world!

We will also drive through the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve & enjoy one of the most famous views in the world, False Bay. Moving on to the Cape of Good Hope which is the southernmost tip of the Peninsula, where (by tradition) two marine ecosystems meet (the Indian Ocean meets the Atlantic). A true highlight.

#### Day 05: Cont'd

We will have time for a relaxing lunch (own expense). We drive through the quaint village of **Simon's Town**, a historic navel base, Fish Hoek and Muizenburg.

On our return to Cape Town, we enjoy a leisurely stroll through **Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens**. We will see some of South Africa's **most spectacular flora**. **Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens** boasts a variety of over 6,000 different plant species.

Upon our return to our hotel, we will have time to relax or enjoy a happy hour. This evening, why not try one of the many restaurants at the V & A Waterfront. **(B)** 

#### Day 06:

This morning after breakfast we will enjoy a short walk to the Clock Tower in the V & A Waterfront. Here, is the beginning of our journey via boat to Robben Island.



world famous for **prison that housed Nelson Mandela**, for many years.

The island's history includes its being used as a sheep farm, a penal settlement, a leper colony, a pauper camp, and infirmary, a mental asylum and a high security prison, where many political prisoners, including South Africa's previous president, **Nelson Mandela** spent many years working in the harsh lime quarries. In addition, we **visit the infamous Maximum Security Prison.** 

We may **spot wild buck**, which are inhabitants of this remote island. From Robben Island, we will have **fantastic photographic opportunities for pictures of Cape Town and Table Mountain**.

We return to the mainland and board our coach and to start our journey eastwards along the India Ocean passing by Gordon's Bay to the quaint town of Hermanus.

En-route we stop at **Stony Point** for close encounters with another colony of the Cape's adorable creatures – **African Jackass Penguins**.

Hermanus, is in this town that we will experience the delightful local culture, small restaurants, numerous

shops, and perhaps hear the sounds of the "Whale Crier" signaling the arrival of the Southern Right Whales in the bay.



#### WE HAVE AN OVERNIGHT STOP IN HERMANUS WHERE WE CAN ENJOY WHALE WATCHING



Hermanus, is a popular resort town situated between mountain and sea, has gained world-wide recognition as the world's foremost land based whale watching destination.

The Southern Right Whales are seen in the bay and surrounding area from July through to November.

Villages in the UK have town criers; Hermanus has its very own **Whale Crier**, and, what's more, Hermanus lays claim to the only whale crier in the world. It's no surprise then to discover the whale crier whose job it is to alert everyone to the whales'



whereabouts. There is a whole series of horn blows that given to indicate different points along the coastline and the number of whales spotted.

The Old Harbour complex in Hermanus offers the visitor an

insight into Hermanus' past as a Fisherman's village and marine life. Hermanus and neighbouring towns Onrus and Stanford, are the residence of a variety of artists, from watercolors, to writers, potters and crafters. Excellent jewelry is produced and crafts of a high standard can be purchased at the popular Craft Market at Lemm's Corner. **(B)** 

#### Day 07:

Following breakfast, we depart from our hotel & travel eastwards along the scenic coastal route. We enter the **spectacular Garden Route** at Heidelberg and take a leisurely drive via Riversdale, established in 1838, and Albertinia, where the Aloe Factory extracts aloe juice and gel for use in medicine and skin care products.

We continue via the **seaside town of Mossel Bay,** and St. Blaize lighthouse is one of the only two manned lighthouses on the South African Coast.

We will **visit the Maritime Museum** which focuses on the sailing and ships of the early days of discovery, home to the impressive life-size replica of Bartolomeu Dias's Caravel, the ship in which he sailed into Mossel Bay in the year 1488. It also displays ship models of a bygone era, route maps to the East.

#### Day 07: Cont'd

Another **must see stop is the Post Office Tree**. One of the most popular attractions is the **Post Office**, which is estimated to be more than 800 years old and has been declared a **National Monument**. It is underneath this *milkwood tree* where Pedro d'Ataide left a letter in 1,500 in a seaman's boot for passing ships. Letters are still posted there today in a seaman's boot!

We continue our **travels via "Route 62"** (U.S.A version of Route 66). is an area of magnificent landscapes & towering cliffs, crystal clear streams & the abundance of trees & indigenous flora. The ever changing colours of the majestic mountains, scenic passes, rivers, vineyards and orchards, offer us an unforgettable kaleidoscope of scenic tranquility.

Route 62 takes us through the **Outeniqua Pass** an on to **Oudtshoorn**, the "Feather Capital of the **World**", thanks to its huge ostrich industry.

Tonight's dinner will be served at our hotel for our relaxation. (B / D)

#### Day 08:

Today, we venture to the world renowned Cango Caves, where nature has sculptured magnificent stalactites & stalagmites. The Cango Caves are one of the world's "Great Natural Wonders", with the world's finest stalactites, providing a magical subterranean journey through massive caverns and fascinating limestone formations. We will enjoy a tour of the main caves.

After our visit to this amazing place, you will be sure to enjoy our visit to the Safari Ostrich Farm for a guided tour of this working ostrich farm as well as a demonstration of



these weird but fascinating birds. Warm dry summers and sunny winter days make this the ideal breeding ground for the ostrich. We may even have time to shop for various forms of local arts and crafts, including many ostrich products.

We now depart Oudsthoorn and travel to the **quaint lagoon Town of Knysna**, most famous for its shopping & Oysters!! We will cross the Outeniqua Pass to Geroge, drive through the **Wilderness and the Lake District to Knysna** – the Heart of the Garden Route. Upon our arrival, we will check into our accommodation (**enjoying TWO nights**).

Tonight's **memorable dinner** is included at the **34 Degrees South Restaurant**, situated at the Knysna Waterfront. Following our delicious dinner why not join Ron on a walkabout! **(B/D)** 

#### Day 09:

Today, after a leisurely breakfast we will **enjoy a short Cruise on the Lagoon** with views of **Famous Knysna Heads.** The Heads are the Most Striking Geological Feathers Along the Entire Southern African Coastline.

The amazing view of the **imposing sandstone** "Heads" which guard the sea entrance to Knysna's huge tidal lagoon, and the forests, marshes and pristine beaches surrounding it. The Knysna Lagoon is protected from the sea by a narrow channel between two sandstone headlands (the Knysna Heads), known as the most perilous entry point to a harbour in the world – it is the only harbour entry for which Lloyd's of London will not insure a vessel.

Our boat ride takes us to the **Featherbed Nature Reserve**, where we will enjoy Panoramic Views of the Town and Lagoon.

Lunch today, is **enjoyed under the Milkwood trees.** The remainder of the afternoon, **is at leisure** to further explore this charming town set around a natural harbour lagoon. **(B/L)** 

#### **Day 10:**

Following our morning breakfast, we check out of our hotel. Our coach drives us to the George Airport for our flight to Johannesburg.

Upon our arrival, we will **enjoy Group Lunch in Soweto**. This is a wonderful and "**truly ethnic South African Restaurant**" offering a buffet-style lunch with a range of traditional African Cuisine - a touch of South Africa.

Following lunch, we will begin on a **Soweto Tour**. Soweto is South Africa's largest and best known "black" city (an obsolete term since the demise of apartheid). This sprawling metropolis of more than 3.5 million people, 100 square kilometers (39 square miles) on the outskirts of Johannesburg, is synonymous with South Africa's turbulent past and its hopes for the future.

Soweto, is a multi-cultural composite of South Africa today. Peek into the past – hostels, **Freedom Square**, the struggle for liberty.

Today, we tread the paths to greatness by Nelson Mandela and Walter Sisulu. We will **visit the Mandela Museum**; stand on the only road in the world, which carries the honor of two recipients of the Nobel Peace Prize and see **Desmond Tutu's home**. **Winnie Mandela's current home** is also in this area.

#### Day 10: Cont'd

We will stop and visit the **Hector Pieterson Memorial and Museum**, situated Soweto, to commemorate the role of the country's students in the struggle against apartheid. The two commemorative sites are just a few blocks from where 12-year-old Hector Pieterson was shot in 1976.

Following our Soweto Tour, we check-in to our hotel, where the remainder of the day is at our own leisure. (B / L)

#### Day 11:

Following breakfast we check out of our hotel and transfer to Ortia Johannesburg Airport, for our flight to **Hoedspruit**.

Upon our arrival, we will transfer to our **Game Reserve Lodge (enjoying THREE nights)**, checkin and have lunch. The northern Drakensberg Mountain Range provides a majestic backdrop to our **private game lodge in Sabi Sands Game** Reserve which is adjacent to Kruger National Park and so shares the same wildlife diversity that makes the the Kruger famous.

Later in the afternoon, we will set off on an exciting GAME DRIVE in the reserve. South Africa is blessed with a wealth of wildlife and indigenous animals. Probably most famous



are the "BIG FIVE", which are, Lion, Leopard, Elephant, Rhino and Cape Buffalo.

During our game drive, we will watch out for the "Big Five" as well as other characteristic species such as the Spotted Hyena, Impala, Nyala, majestically horned Kudu, White Bushbuck, Sable Antelope, Zebra, Giraffe and Wildebeest.

Upon our arrival back at our lodge, we have time to freshen up and enjoy dinner at our lodge. (B/L/D)

#### Day 12:

An exciting morning! We depart on our morning open vehicle game drive in the Game Reserve – once again, in search of Africa's Big Five!

There are a number of plant and animal species that are not found, or are rare, on the wooded slopes and valleys and elsewhere in South Africa.

#### Day 12: Cont'd

We return from our exciting morning game drive to enjoy a wonderful breakfast. We will now have **time to enjoy our lodge**. There is a lounge, bar, curio shop and an inviting swimming pool. The scenery surrounding the lodge is absolutely breathtaking.

**High Tea is served** before venturing on a gameviewing drive.

Our Game Reserve in an area renowned for superb safari vacations, boasting the 'Big Five' - Lion, Leopard, Elephant, Rhino & Cape Buffalo.
Other characteristic species are Cheetah, Giraffe, Zebra and Kudu.



Game drives are conducted through the rolling savannah grasslands and riverine forests that make up this appealing African reserve. Make sure you bring plenty of film and a pair of binoculars.

Dinner tonight will be at our Safari Lodge. (B / L / D)

#### Day 13:

We set off in our safari vehicles in search of **Lion**, **Elephant**, **Buffalo**, **Rhino and Leopard**, and all manner of wondrous wildlife, birds and plants besides. As we travel, we will **savour the magic of this enormous wilderness**.

Breakfast is enjoyed at leisure, upon our return. The remainder of the day is for your comfort "at leisure", where you will be sure to enjoy our lodge facilities.

Following High Tea, we will depart for our final afternoon. Our safari will include leisurely game drives through herds of Impala, Wildebeest, Giraffe and Zebra.



We shall pause for photographic opportunities and keep an eagle eye open for Lion, Elephant, Rhino, Buffalo, the elusive Leopard and many other exciting occurrences!

Dinner will be served at our Safari Lodge, later this evening. (B/L/D)

#### Day 14:

This morning we have a breakfast and check out. So.... let's check our animal sightings list: Elephant, Lion, Cape Buffalo, White Rhino, Leopard, Giraffe, Nyala, Zebra, Klipspringer, Kudu, Rock Elephant Shrew, and 269 bird species (well maybe not all 269!!).

#### Day 14: Cont'd

Today, we will continue on our travels bidding farewell to the bush and traveling north. The PANORAMA ROUTE, is world renowned for its stunning beauty and scenic viewpoints. This is the area, where the highland meets the escarpment leading down to the lowland.

The Blyde River Canyon drops a thousand meters into the heavily wooded valley which goes onwards for miles. This offers the visitor absolutely stunning views from such well named spots as God's Window, Wonder View, The Pinnacle, The Three Rondavels and Bourke's Luck Potholes.

We will continue to the small town of Pilgrim's Rest. Pilgrim's Rest was born during the excitement of an alluvial gold rush.



The entire place has been declared a National

**Monument** and its history allegedly began when 'Wheelbarrow' Alec Patterson, who pushed his belongings along in front of him, panned for gold in the stream running through the valley. Upon hearing of his success he was soon joined by hundreds of others.

Traveling through the gold and coal mining towns onwards to Johannesburg.

Johannesburg, to all intent and purposes the economic capital of South Africa and indeed even sub-Saharan Africa, arose from a dusty and underdeveloped mining town to become a metropolis attracting score of immigrants from northern African countries to find work in the city colloquially known as eGoli, the City of Gold.

Upon **arrival into Johannesburg** we will check into our accommodation upon arrive. **(B)** 

#### Day 15:

This morning, following breakfast, we depart for the airport as we now fly onto **Victoria Falls.** Upon our arrival, we check into the comforts of our Lodge.

The Victoria Falls Safari Lodge is set high on a plateau, which forms a natural boundary to the unfenced Zambezi National Park, and is just a few kilometres from the majestic Victoria Falls.

The lodge is westward facing with an **onsite** waterhole, which attracts a wide variety of game throughout the year, ensuring year-round stunning sunsets and magical views of unspoiled bush.

# Victoria Falls, one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World.
